The year was 1945 when thirty young people of Christ Church United formed the "Christ Church Opera Group," with a performance of *HMS Pinafore*.

Our first 23 years were devoted to presenting Gilbert and Sullivan operettas but this tradition was broken in 1969 with a production of Franz Lehár's *The Merry Widow*. Since then, we have visited Oklahoma, Anatevka, New York and the London of Oliver Twist, and Fagin through the music of many of the masters of musical theatre.

In 1973 we changed to our present name and in 1974 we became affiliated with the City of Mississauga.

We have participated in numerous community celebrations such as Carassauga, Erin Mill's Harvest Festival and the re-opening of an expanded Square One. Our Choir and Cabaret Group have provided concerts and shows in many Seniors' residences in Mississauga and Oakville.

We add another dimension to our history with our forth concert at The Living Arts Centre.
